Mr. Mills's super realistic paintings are so lifelike that often they are mistaken for photographs. His work demonstrates his skill, technical ability and meticulous rendering of every detail. His ability to transpose the subtleties of refracting light through glass marbles or the glimmer of chrome to canvas causes one to gaze in marvel.

During his career as a painter, Mr. Mills has received recognition both na-

tionally and internationally. His notoriety has earned him several commissions. Past shows have underscored the popularity of his work, once selling all of his new work in a single evening.
